## Please note the following

- 1. Photocopies of Australian documents (citizenship, Copy of the passport, Australian education qualification, Australian birth certificate, etc.) need to be authenticated by the department of foreign affairs and trade prior to the appointment with the Consulate.

  DFAT authentication can only occur once a notary public has 'certified' or 'legalised' photocopies of certificates. (Authentication done on the original citizenship certificate is not accepted). Please call DFAT for more details.
- 2. Affidavit needs to be signed in front of a JP prior to the appointment with the Consulate
- 3. Please bring 3 copies of every document to the appointment. (All the documents must be printed or copied on a single side. Double sided copies are not accepted.) Please refer to the PDF Application form and supporting documents organizing, on how to organize the 3 sets of documents.
  - 4. All printed and copied documents must be in A4 size. (Sri Lankan birth certificates and Marriage certificates should be reduced in size to fit A4 paper)
